NOTE: McCreary County is $85 \%$ federally owned so there is very little tax base. Have two major factories - One in Stearn and the other out Hwy 92 W (Outdoors Adventure Tent Co.) which is a federal contract to produce tents. The prison handles 1,000 prisons and the airport can fly in corporate jets).
There are 17,000 people accounted for in McCreary County. Sixty of them are millionaires. Salersville and Strunk used to be coal camps that have now merged into one small community Mr. Strunk had 26 boys....Thus the huge number of Strunks you will meet.

ACROSS FROM 92 EAST IS HWY 1651 WEST Which takes you to PINE KNOT, REVELO and then connects with Hwy 92 at STEARNS. Needs signs on Hwy 27 for Stearns Scenic Railway, Barthell, Blue Heron, Yamacraw Falls, Sheltowee Trail
