
APPENDIX F-1SITE OF PROPOSED TRAILHEAD IN CUMBERLAND



The proposed site for the Cumberland Trailhead on city property is strategically located at the intersection of East Main and the proposed Rails-to-Trails that will connect the City of Cumberland to proposed trailheads at Putney and Partridge.

Trail users could come down Sawmill Hollow from the Little Shepherd Trail, come out at Spring Avenue then travel just a block and a half down Kingdom Come Avenue before coming to the Cumberland Trailhead where one has the option to:

1. Take the rails-to-trails west into Cumberland and/or continue to Putney Trailhead,

or

2. Head east to the Trailhead at Partridge. Once a connector trail is added connecting the Putney Trailhead to Little Shepherd Trail, a looped trail system of significant length will be created that to attract riders from outside the area.

Note: All buildings north of the site down to the corner of Kingdom Come Avenue and East Main are scheduled for demolition by U.S. Corps of Engineers due to being in the flood plain. Removal of these structures may open opportunities to develop a connector trail from Spring Avenue to the Trailhead. Follow-up is recommended
